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Introduction

Tropimed®PDA is a simplified version of Tropimed®.

Its purpose is to provide first level information to professionals who, for a variety of reasons, may not be able to access the complete version of Tropimed® available on the Internet and on CD-ROM. Tropimed®PDA is distributed as an e-book and uses technology developed by Mobipocket (an amazon.com company). It is compatible with many devices. This description considers the Palm E2 however, with exceptions for each case, it may serve as a reference for the other devices.

1. Using this Guide

This guide is designed to familiarize new users with the Tropimed®PDA interface and to provide additional information for current users.

2. Demo Version

You may download the demo version of Tropimed®PDA free of charge. The demo version only contains information for the first five countries in the list. No technical support is offered to users of the demo version.

3. Mobipocket Reader

The use of Tropimed®PDA requires prior installation of the Mobipocket Reader (hereafter referred to as the Reader) on both your computer and your PDA.

The Reader may be downloaded free of charge on the Mobipocket website.

3.1 Downloading the Reader

Please go to the web page www.mobipocket.com/en/DownloadSoft/default.asp to download the Mobipocket Reader. You are recommended to backup the file on your desktop so it may be easily located.

3.2 Installing the Reader

3.2.1 PC installation

- Open the downloaded file
- Follow the instructions on the screen

3.2.2 PDA installation

- Connect the PDA to the PC
- Launch Mobipocket Reader

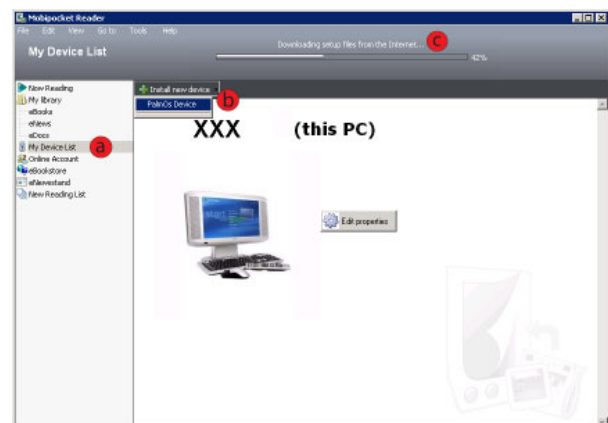


Fig. 1 Installing the Reader on PC

- Click on «My Device List» [Fig. 1a] and then on «Install new device»
- Select your PDA [Fig. 1b] and the profile you wish to install on the Mobipocket Reader
- Complete the «Downloading setup files» process [Fig. 1c]

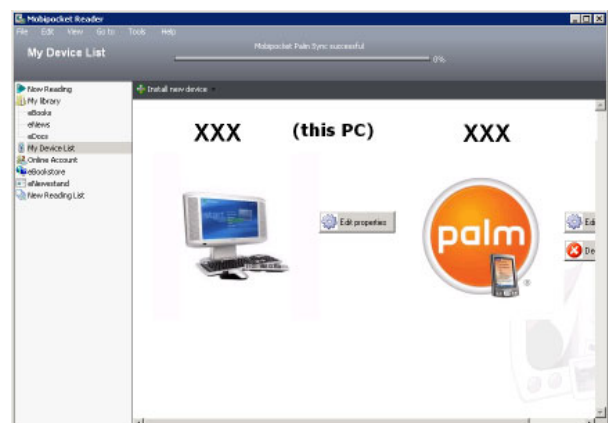


Fig. 2 Installing the Reader on PDA device - HotSync

- Perform a HotSync and wait until your PDA appears on the screen [Fig. 2]
- When installation is complete, a Mobipocket icon will appear on your PDA desktop [fig. 3].

a. My device list menu b. Device List c. Setup process status

3.3 Configuring and Navigation

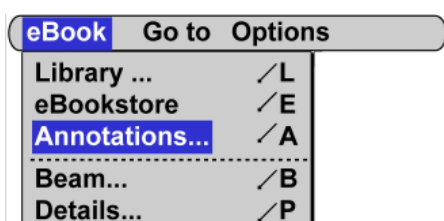


Fig. 5 The main toolbar

Once installed on your PDA, you may customize the Mobipocket Reader navigation tools [Fig. 4]. To do this, click on «Options» and then «Preferences» in the Mobipocket toolbar [Fig. 5]. For optimum use of Tropimed®PDA, you are recommended to have the following commands available:

1. Open library 2. About 3. Open Main menu of TropimedPDA 4. Full screen mode 5. Font size 6. Autoscroll 7. Back to previous step 8. Back to previous page 9. Go to the next page

3.4 Searching and Toolbar

The main toolbar, located at the top of the screen, is used to access the main Reader functions [Fig. 5].

The «Annotation» command is excellent for relocating highlighted information that you've already found.

4. Tropimed®PDA

4.1 Installing Tropimed®PDA

1. Open the file TropimedPDA.prc;
2. The file is opened with Mobipocket Reader
3. Click on «File» and on «Send to Handheld»
4. Select the PDA.

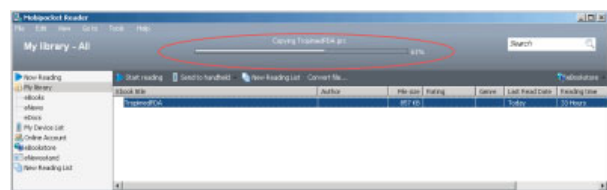


Fig. 6 Mobipocket Reader screen on the PC during installation of Tropimed®PDA.

5. Perform a HotSync to copy Tropimed on your PDA [Fig. 6].

4.2 Launching Tropimed®PDA

Use the icon that appears on the desktop of your PDA to launch The Reader [Fig. 3]. Refresh the application « Main toolbar [Fig 5] > Options > Refresh».

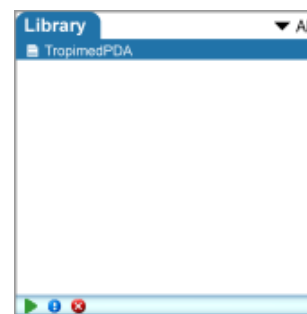


Fig. 7 Mobipocket Library

The Mobipocket Reader library may contain other programs. In this case, choose TropimedPDA [Fig. 7].

4.3 Homepage – Main menu

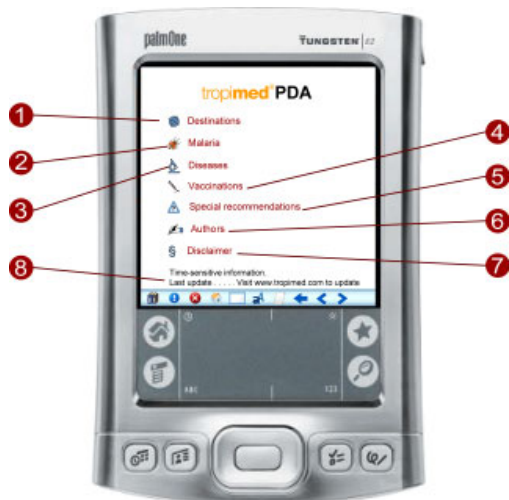


Fig. 8 Tropimed®PDA: Homepage

3 distinct areas will appear when you launch Tropimed®PDA [Fig. 8]:

- The Tropimed®PDA menu with input criteria
- The date of the update
- The navigation area.

4.5 Country Page

This page [Fig. 10] is displayed by clicking on a destination. It includes 3 sections:

4.5.1 Malaria

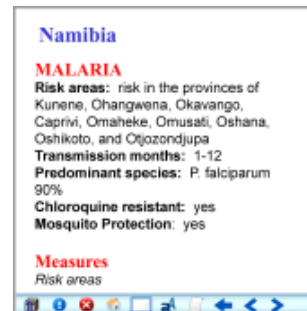


Fig. 11 Namibia Country Page: Malaria section.

This section provides all information on malaria (if any exists) in the chosen country. The topics are: Risk area, Transmission months, Chloroquine resistance, Chemoprophylaxis and Presumptive Self-Treatment measures. [Fig. 11]

4.5.2 Vaccinations

List of the 13 vaccinable diseases that may be encountered when travelling, including:

- The risk of contracting the diseases

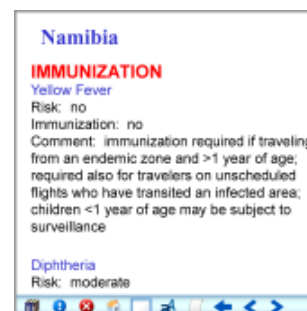


Fig.12 Namibia Country Page: Vaccination section.

- Recommendations on the vaccinations [Fig. 12]
- Comments
- The link on the vaccination document of each disease.

4.5.3 Additional Risks

List of diseases for the destination considered [Fig. 13]:

- The risk of contracting the diseases
- The modes of transmission
- Comments
- The link on the document of each disease.

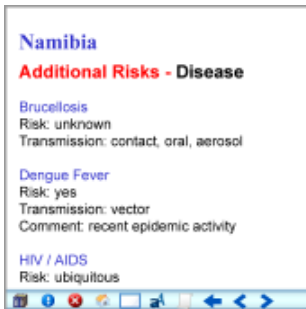


Fig. 14 Namibia Country Page: Additional Risks section.

4.6 Others Chapter

From the Tropimed®PDA main menu [Fig.8], you may also display the other chapters. Each chapter proposes the list of associated documents that may be viewed.

Malaria Chapter: The list of malaria-related documents.

Disease Chapter: The list of more than 60 documents on diseases.

Vaccinations Chapter: The list of documents on vaccinations.

Special Recommendations Chapter: Special recommendations on subjects that may concern a certain type of travel (e.g. by boat and cruiser, photosensitivity, vaccines for immunocompromised persons, etc.)

5 Updates

5.1 Obtaining the Latest Update

- Go to the website www.tropimed.com
- Login and go to the download area and then download the latest version.

5.2 How to install the update

After you **uninstall** any previous **version**, please follow the instructions at the step § 4.1.

5.3 Uninstalling a Previous Versions

Any previous version on your computer or PDA must be removed **BEFORE** you begin installing the latest version.

1. Open the Mobipocket Reader on your PDA
2. Select the Tropimed®PDA ebook

3. Click on the Delete icon

4 Repeat steps 1-3 on you PC if necessary.

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
